3. Protest & KEEP PROTESTING: uscpr.org/protests

<u>Find a protest near you.</u> Text and invite all your friends. Ask everyone in attendance to complete one of the above action tools on the spot.

NEW: No business as usual! Organize your own protest to hold your members of Congress accountable. Hold a <u>sit-in</u> or <u>pray-in</u> based on recent examples, using <u>organizing resources</u>. Keep up the pressure!

Print protest signs to take along.

5. NEW: Sign up for action alert texts

Make sure you're plugged in to the most critical updates in real time. With so much censorship on social media, getting texts sent directly to your phone is the fastest way to find out about new action alerts.

6. NEW: Look up: How much of your community's tax dollars fund Israel's violence?

Every year, the U.S. government writes Israel a blank check for at least \$3.8 billion. With your federal U.S. tax dollars, the Israeli military is bombing Gaza and wiping out entire Palestinian families right now.

How much do people in your city pay through federal tax dollars? What could be funded instead? Find out above on the U.S. Military Funding to Israel map, and demand Congress #StopArmingIsrael.

7. NEW: Boycott, Divestment, & Sanctions (BDS)
